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### What makes Belli different?

Belli is the only skin care company in the world that performs Teratology screening of our ingredients through the MEDLINE, TOXLINE, DART and TERIS teratology databases.

## What is Teratology?

You may have heard of the word Toxicology before... it is the study of chemicals that are harmful to humans. Teratology is the study of chemicals that are harmful to the developing fetus.

## Why is Teratology important to me?

Published studies show links between common skin care ingredients and birth defects when taken either orally or systemically.

Just a few examples of these include:

Vitamin A, salicylic acid, benzoyl peroxide, caffeine, aloe vera, oxybenzone (a chemical sunscreen) and BHT (an antioxidant)

# But why is this important when I am only putting it ON my skin not in my mouth?

Very few studies have looked at the teratogenicity of these and other ingredients when applied topically. Yet we know that many skin care ingredients are absorbed into the bloodstream where they can potentially interact with the developing fetus.

At Belli we set the new standard for pre natal safety in the skin care industry going above and beyond.


# Is that all the research and testing that Belli does?

No, products are sent to an independent laboratory for skin irritation testing, followed by a nine-week extensive trial of repeat insult patch testing to establish hypoallergenicity.

Our Motherhood range is also LACTMED screened and we exclude any ingredients known to be harmful to nursing babies through the breast milk.

So at Belli we make sure our products are not only safe for your baby but also for YOU!

# Is Belli all-organic?

Belli uses many organic ingredients, but the "organic" label alone does not mean that an ingredient is safe during pregnancy. Even some natural, organically grown skin care ingredients have links to birth defects in published medical studies—including aloe vera, rosemary, salicylic acid, caffeine, and glycolic acid.

Teratology screening helps ensure you are using the safest known ingredients during pregnancy, from any source. It eliminates ingredients with links to birth defects in published medical studies, and replaces them with safer choices instead. Belli has lead the industry with this higher prenatal safety standard since 2002. When the research shows that a natural ingredient is the safest choice, we do prefer to purchase from organic farmers to avoid possible contamination with pesticides. We also do not test on animals.
